Gateway Neighborhood Sponsorship & Investment Opportunities

CORPORATE INVESTMENT OVERVIEW

Through New Jersey’s Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Credit (NRTC) program, corporations can redirect a portion of their state tax liability to community-based projects that generate measurable social and economic benefits. Participating businesses receive a 100% state tax credit and public recognition as active partners in local revitalization.

Corporate partners can choose projects that match their philanthropic goals, community involvement plans, or brand values. Instead of sending part of their state taxes into the general fund, companies can apply for tax credits that go directly to state-approved projects, such as PARTNERS. These investments help with housing, workforce training, small-business development, and neighborhood programs through the NRTC framework.

This structure creates a true win-win opportunity, enabling corporations to meet their civic and social impact goals while receiving meaningful visibility through sponsorship recognition, naming opportunities, and employee engagement initiatives.

FEATURED PROGRAM IMPACT (2024–2025)

PROGRAM SUPPORT

Housing & Financial Empowerment

Gateway’s First-Time Homebuyer Workshops and Home Harmony Program help residents achieve and sustain homeownership.

- 40 residents completed homeownership education sessions.
- 9 home repair projects are underway with a **goal of 14 by 2026**.



Career Fairs & Workforce Development

Gateway’s Career Fairs continue to be a cornerstone of local workforce engagement, connecting more than **1,600 job seekers** with employers, training providers, and community resources. Hosted in partnership with the City of Perth Amboy, Middlesex College, and the Housing Authority, these events strengthen employment pathways and economic mobility for local residents.

Career Fair Highlights:

- June 12, 2024: 23 employers participated; 530 job seekers attended.
- April 8, 2025: 23 employers and 5 community resource partners; 619 job seekers attended.
- September 23, 2025: 33 employers participated; 544 job seekers attended.

Total Impact: Over 1,600 job seekers connected with nearly 80 employers and partners across three highly successful events.

SMALL BUSINESS GROWTH & AMBOY EATS PROGRAM

PerthAmboyEats.com is a new website created to give local restaurants greater visibility and attract new customers from Perth Amboy and surrounding towns. The goal is to highlight the city’s vibrant culinary scene and invite both residents and visitors to discover and enjoy diverse dining options.

Community Events & Arts Engagement

Movie Nights

Gateway organizes family-friendly and cultural events that strengthen local pride and unity. Highlights include Movie Nights Under the Stars, Farewell Summer Concert, and Art & Music in the Gateway, drawing hundreds of residents annually. We average over 60 residents per community events.



Art & Music in the Gateway

Summer of 2025, P.A.R.T.N.E.R. hosted the Farewell Summer Concert at the Gateway Amphitheater, a lively evening of music, dance, and community celebration. The event brought together 277 residents, making it one of the most well-attended community gatherings of the year. The concert showcased local talent and highlighted the Gateway neighborhood’s growing reputation as a hub for arts, culture, and connection.



Parks Development

Visible improvements make Gateway a more welcoming, vibrant place to live and work. Projects include new planters, park benches, and community art installations.



Health & Wellness

Community clean-ups, senior wellness programs, and outdoor fitness events help create a safer, healthier environment for families.

Community Clean-Up Initiatives (2025)

P.A.R.T.N.E.R. and the Gateway Neighborhood Collaborative coordinated several successful clean-up efforts in collaboration with the City of Perth Amboy’s Green Team and community organizations. Activities included participation in the Citywide Earth Day Clean-Up and ongoing neighborhood beautification events. 2025 Highlights:

- **April 26** – Patten Center Park Clean-Up with over 15 volunteers.
- **May 17** – Green Team Clean-Up with First Responders & Fire Department with over 30 volunteers.
- **October 25** – Gateway Clean-Up with AARP Free Shred Truck with 12 volunteers, 47 carloads serviced, 10,000 lbs. of documents securely destroyed.

Total Impact: 57 volunteers engaged and 40 bags of litter collected across all events.
